

TOWN OF CLEVELAND ORDINANCE NO. 2026-05

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATV and UTV)

The Town Board of the Town of Cleveland, Jackson County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. A Town of Cleveland Ordinance is hereby created to read as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance Title. "Regulation of All Terrain Vehicles (ATV and UTV)"

Section 2.

a) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Ordinance, the statutory provisions of Wis. Stat. §23.33, Wis. Stats. §340, Wis. Admin. Code NR §64, describing and defining regulations with respect to all-terrain vehicles are adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute or administrative code incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes or administrative code incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Code in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of all-terrain vehicles.


b) The operation of an ATV or UTV on a roadway that is an approved ATV / UTV Route and which is signed in accordance with Wis. Stat. §23.33(8)(e) by the Town of Cleveland, or it's designee is subject to the provisions set forth in this Ordinance, as well as all other applicable statutory provisions.

ARTICLE 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable, and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons and/or circumstances shall not be deemed affected.


ARTICLE 3. All other Town of Cleveland ordinances that are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


